To qualify, YOU must:

- Be at least 17 years of age
- Have an interest in transportation technology
- Be in good academic standing
- Demonstrate strong work habits and a positive attitude
- Have a working knowledge of general mathematical principles

A selection committee that includes industry partners may interview candidates. A limited number of spaces are available.

Program components include:

- Grade 12 or year 5 students attend their home school for semester one for four classes
- Students will spend three days a week at the workplace, and two days at Mohawk College completing the Level One Apprenticeship in-school training.
- Students will receive Truck and Coach Technician Apprenticeship training in an ultra modern facility at Mohawk College.

Program Credits/Certification:

- Upon successfully completing the program, the student will:
- Receive four coop credits in the work place and graduate from your home school
- Successfully complete the "Level One" Apprenticeship training for Truck and Coach Technician with valuable work experience and extensive skills training

A Guidance Counsellor or Cooperative Education teacher must help you to complete an application form for the Accelerated Program and submit all required documents.

This program combines instruction at the home school and Mohawk College and provides a Cooperative Education placement in the automotive repair and maintenance industry. It is offered in Semester Two and is open to students in Grade 12 or in their 5th year of secondary school.
