The St. Charles Continuing Education Department administers the HWCDSB Summer Cooperative Education/OYAP Program.

### How can the Summer SHSM Cooperative Education/OYAP Program help high school students?

Through the Summer SHSM Cooperative Education/OYAP experience, the student will have the opportunity to:

- Explore a career or job, and be trained by skilled professionals
- Earn 2 credits toward their Ontario Secondary School Diploma requirements.
- Build essential skills in preparation for school, work, apprenticeship training or post-secondary education pathways.
- Participate in seasonal job or career areas whose peak productivity occurs in the summer.

### How is the Summer SHSM Cooperative Education/OYAP Program delivered?

- The Summer Cooperative Education/OYAP Program is a 2- credit (220 hour) course.
- Students who are applying to the program will complete the application and provide all accompanying paperwork to the SHSM Counselor
- The Summer Cooperative Education Teacher will contact the students to determine admission into the program.
- Daily attendance is compulsory in this fast-paced program.
- Transportation to and from the Cooperative Education placement is the responsibility of the student.

- □ Credit Counseling Summary
- Students applying for Health Care placements ADDITIONALLY MUST have either St Joe's Application and Immunization forms completed, or Hamilton Health Sciences immune forms completed.

### ONLY COMPLETE APPLICATION PACKAGES WILL BE CONSIDERED

Late admissions will only be considered if the student provides the placement and space is available.
