### Did you know?

- There are 54 industrial trades in Ontario, none of which are compulsory\*
- Together, the industrial trades generate nearly a quarter of Ontario's economic wealth
- In the next 20 years, 40% of new jobs in Canada will be in skilled trades and technologies
- In the last 10 years, the average weekly wage of workers with a trades certificate grew by 14%
